PASTOR'S CORNER

My Dear Parish Family,

In our world today, many of our lives are dictated by commercial trends. We go from one holiday to the next being driven and directed simply by commercial impulses imposed upon us by the secular world. Unfortunately, Christmas too has been subjected to this same level of commercialization. Many people often worry about what they will wear before they think about the state of their souls. We give priority to what we clad over what makes us glad. On this **FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT**, I invite you to make this season a time of spiritual preparation for Christmas; a time to create space for God in our hearts; a time to yearn for his face. Let us reclaim the spiritual value of this time of the year. During this Advent, I ask you to adopt a spiritual exercise. For example, say a rosary daily, read the Bible daily, consider making a good confession or try to go on a retreat. Also, get a copy of the parish's Advent devotional, *Our Journey Toward Joy* by S. James Meyer, which contains daily meditations. We also have devotionals for children. Use that for meditation and prayer. We can and should make this Christmas a very special celebration through our preparation this Advent.

The Advent season is always punctuated by celebrations that help to enhance the awe and wonder in beholding the face of our Redeemer at Christmas. I ask you to consider celebrating the sacrament of reconciliation with us during our Advent Penance Service on Tuesday, December 10 at 7pm. Prepare the way for the Lord. I also invite you to consider joining us for the celebration of the **FEAST OF OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE (PATRONESS OF THE AMERICAS) ON THURSDAY, DECEMBER 12**. The celebration begins at 7pm with special dances, the Mass and a reenactment of the apparition of Mary. We hope you can join us.

God bless you this Advent and see you at Mass!

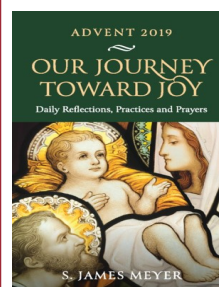

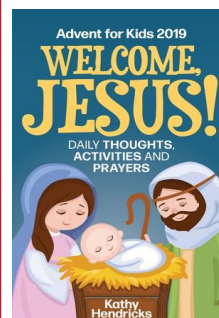

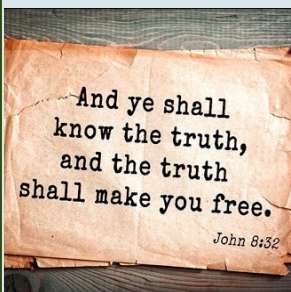


CHRISTMAS PAGEANT

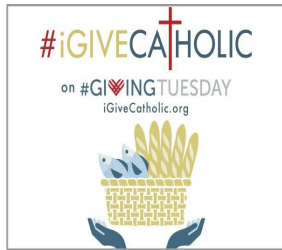

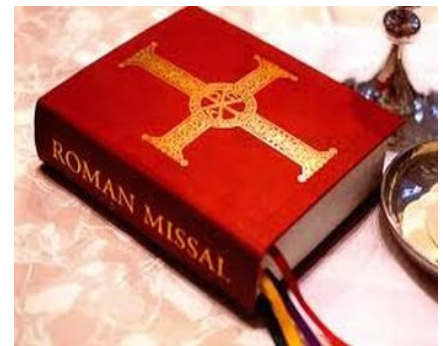
