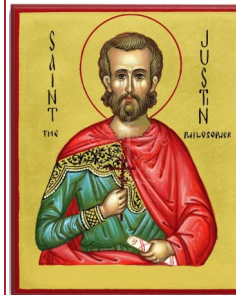

GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING MASS

PLEASE FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS OF THE USHERS



Masses at St George will resume at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 26. All Masses will be held in the main Sanctuary. The weekday Mass schedule will be: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday at 11:00am. Weekend Mass will be Saturday at 5pm, and Sunday at 8am, 10am and 12:30pm (Spanish).

The Mass schedule is designed to make Mass as accessible as possible for all who wish to attend. However *the dispensation from attending Mass has been extended by the Archbishop to June 28, 2020*. This means that you are not required to go to Mass on Sunday or any other day of the week. It is not a sin if you do not attend.

New protocol for attending Mass at St George is as follows:

Everyone 10 years old and over MUST wear a mask. No extra masks will be available, so if you do not have a mask, you will not be admitted.

Observe social distancing. *No more than 5 persons per pew.* Maximum Mass attendance with overflow seating in the Parish Hall is 200 persons. Families with more than 5 persons may sit together in the same pew. The Cry Room in the main Sanctuary is not to be used.

Check your temperature before you leave the house. If it is 100 degrees or more, please STAY HOME.

You will enter the church through the Parish Hall entrance and leave through one of the two main Sanctuary side entrances which lead out directly to the parking lot.

No physical contact is permitted between non-family members throughout the Mass. There will be no holding of hands during the "Our Father," and the sign of peace will be omitted from the Mass. Holy Communion will be received **IN THE HAND ONLY**; reception of the precious blood is suspended until further notice. Ushers will direct traffic flow for Communion in order to maintain physical distancing.

We shall have offertory baskets at the back of the church when you enter. You can drop your collection at that time or at the door on your way out with the ushers.

The church will be sprayed and sanitized after each Mass. However, hand sanitizers and other cleaning materials will not be provided, so please bring your own if you can. (Sundays for 10:00 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. Masses only: Please arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to Mass so that we have enough time to sanitize the church between Masses).

Al reabrir la Iglesia, somos muy conscientes de sus preocupaciones y estamos totalmente comprometidos con su seguridad. Por lo tanto, abriremos la Iglesia con cuidado; continuen respetando las reglas y pautas de distanciamiento social para minimizar el contacto físico y la exposición al tiempo que se garantiza que todos puedan disfrutar de las bendiciones de asistir una vez más a la misa.

Las misas en San Jorge se reanudarán a las 11:00 a.m. el Martes 26 de Mayo. Todas las Misas se llevarán a cabo en la Iglesia. El horario de misas entre semana será: Lunes, Martes, Miércoles y Viernes a las 11:00 a.m. Las Misas de fin de semana serán los Sábados a las 5:00 p.m. (Vigilia) y los domingos a las 8:00 a.m., 10:00 a.m. y 12:30 p.m. (español). El horario de misa está diseñado para hacer que la misa sea lo más accesible posible para todos los que deseen asistir. Esto significa que no está obligado a ir a misa el Domingo o cualquier otro día de la semana. No es pecado si no asistes.

Con eso, se deben seguir estrictamente las siguientes pautas. El nuevo protocolo para asistir a misa en San Jorge es el siguiente:

Todos los mayores de 10 años DEBEN usar una máscara. No habrá máscaras adicionales disponibles, por lo que, si no tiene una máscara, no será admitido.

Observar el distanciamiento social. No más de 5 personas por banco. La asistencia máxima a misa con asientos desbordados en el Salón Parroquial es de 200 personas. Las familias con más de 5 personas pueden sentarse juntas en el mismo banco. La sala de llanto en el santuario principal no se debe utilizar.

Verifique su temperatura antes de salir de la casa. Si es 100 grados o más, por favor quédese en casa.

Entrarás a la iglesia a través de la entrada del Salón Parroquial y saldrás por una de las dos entradas principales del Santuario que conducen directamente al estacionamiento.

No se permite el contacto físico entre miembros no familiares durante la Misa. No se tomarán de las manos durante el "Padre Nuestro", y el signo de paz se omitirá de la Misa. La Sagrada Comunión se recibirá SOLO EN LA MANO; Se suspende la recepción de la preciosa sangre hasta nuevo aviso. Los ujieres dirigirán el flujo de tráfico para la comunión a fin de mantener el distanciamiento físico.

Tendremos cestas de ofertorio en la parte de atrás de la iglesia cuando entren. Pueden dejar su ofertorio en ese momento o en la puerta al salir con los ujieres.

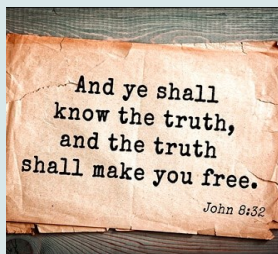
La Iglesia será rociada y desinfectada después de cada Misa. Sin embargo, no se proporcionarán desinfectantes para manos y otros materiales de limpieza, así que por favor traiga el suyo si puede. (Domingos para las 10:00 a.m. y las 12:30 p.m. Misas solamente: llegue no antes de 15 minutos antes de la misa para que tengamos tiempo suficiente para desinfectar la iglesia entre misas).

Finalmente, siga las instrucciones de los ujieres. Han sido capacitados e instruidos sobre lo que hay que hacer para garantizar que todos estén seguros.
