PASTOR'S CORNER

My Dear Parish Family,

This week is National Vocation Awareness Week. An integral part of the mission of the church is to fulfill one of the most important yet basic invitations of Christ: *Pray that the master of the harvest will send more laborers into the harvest* (Mt. 9:38). By inviting us to pray for an increase in vocations, Christ wants us to recognize that every vocation is born from an intimate connection between man and God. God supplies when we ask. When we pray for vocations, what should we to pray for? What vocations are we praying for? Many Catholics often believe that the only vocations in the church which we need to pray for are the vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Yes, we do need priests and religious, but this is a grave error. The word "vocation" comes from the Latin term *vocare* which means "to call". Every vocation is a call from God to serve Him here on earth. There are two main vocations in the church: the priesthood and religious life which are vocations of service and marriage which is a vocation of communion.

The marriage vocation is as important as the vocation to the priesthood and religious life because it is foundational to both. The seeds of every good and holy vocation to the priesthood and religious life are sown first and foremost in the family. The home is the place where primary formation begins. Parents have an indispensable role to play in nurturing every vocation to the priesthood and religious life. Therefore, the task of fostering vocations is entrusted primarily to the family. During this National Vocation Awareness Week, it is our responsibility to listen, once more, to the voice of the Good Shepherd to pray for more laborers in the harvest. We must begin by asking God for stable, healthy and holy marriages. The spiritual health of the family has a direct impact on the spiritual health of every vocation to the priesthood and religious life.

God bless you and see you at Mass!

ESQUINA DEL PARROCO

Mi Querida Familia Parroquial,

*Esta semana es la Semana Nacional de Concientización sobre las Vocaciones. Una parte integral de la misión de la iglesia es cumplir una de las invitaciones más importantes pero básicas de Cristo: orar para que el maestro de la cosecha envíe más trabajadores a la cosecha (Mt. 9:38). Al invitarnos a orar por un aumento en las vocaciones, Cristo quiere que reconozcamos que cada vocación nace de una conexión íntima entre el hombre y Dios. Dios suple cuando pedimos. Cuando oramos por las vocaciones, ¿por qué debemos orar? ¿Por qué vocaciones rezamos? Muchos católicos a menudo creen que las únicas vocaciones en la iglesia por las que debemos orar son las vocaciones al sacerdocio y la vida religiosa. Sí, necesitamos sacerdotes y religiosos, pero esto es un grave error. La palabra "vocación" proviene del término latino *vocare*, que significa "llamar". Toda vocación es un llamado de Dios para servirle aquí en la tierra. Hay dos vocaciones principales en la iglesia: el sacerdocio y la vida religiosa que son vocaciones de servicio y también está el matrimonio que es una vocación de comunión.*

La vocación matrimonial es tan importante como la vocación al sacerdocio y la vida religiosa porque es fundamental para ambos. Las semillas de toda buena y santa vocación al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa se siembran ante todo en la familia. El hogar es el lugar donde comienza la formación primaria. Los padres tienen un papel indispensable que desempeñar para nutrir cada vocación al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa. Por lo tanto, la tarea de fomentar las vocaciones se confía principalmente a la familia. Durante esta Semana Nacional sobre Vocaciones, es nuestra responsabilidad escuchar, una vez más, la voz del Buen Pastor para rezar por más trabajadores en la cosecha. Debemos comenzar pidiéndole a Dios matrimonios estables, saludables y santos. La salud espiritual de la familia tiene un impacto directo en la salud espiritual de cada vocación al sacerdocio y a la vida religiosa.

Dios los bendiga y nos vemos en la misa!

I am reverent at Mass because I believe in the Real Presence. Jesus Christ is truly present in the Holy Eucharist!



Here are some recommendations on how to celebrate Mass with reverence:

- † Arrive at church early so that you can prepare yourself spiritually before entering into the mystery of the Holy Mass.
- † Dress properly in order to show God that you respect and adore Him. Avoid wearing shorts, flipflops, strapless, etc. Remember, you are in the presence of the King of kings and the Lord of lords.
- † Join in singing the hymns and responding to the prayers. We are here to dialogue with God. Also, He has given you a voice to use for His glory and honor.
- † Hold your hands together in reverence (**praying hands**) during the prayers and especially when you are coming to receive Holy Communion. It is God Himself you are consuming.
- † After receiving Holy Communion, we should return to our seats and offer a prayer of thanksgiving.
- † Leaving Mass right after Holy Communion is disrespectful to God.

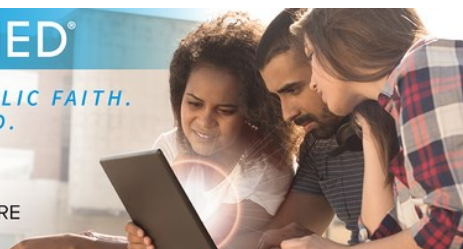

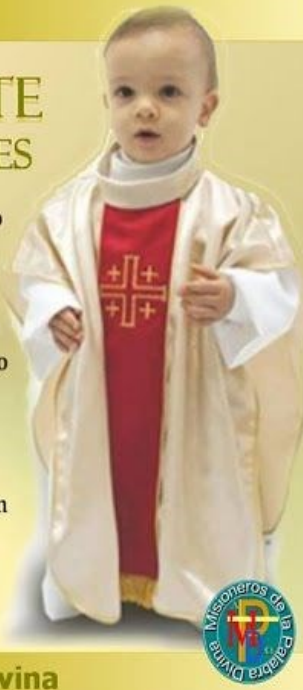
